This Kanji list is compiled from the 104 Kanji which are the prerequisite for Japanese Proficiency Test N5 and the 16 Kanji possibly tested (These words are selected from the past tests by MLC).

■ Kanji No. 1 – 320: 284 + 36


This Kanji list is compiled from the 284 Kanji which are the prerequisite for Japanese Proficiency Test N4 and the 36 Kanji possibly tested (These words are selected from the past tests by MLC).

The order of Kanji is from the easy one to the difficult. The related words are arranged in a group by MLC.

The required “Japanese Reading of Kanji” in “Hiragana” and “Chinese Reading of Kanji” in “Katakana” are shown.



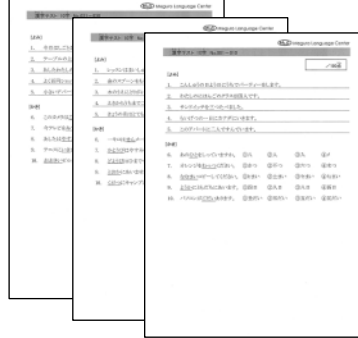
These are the examples. The diamond(♦) put on the Kanji which are not necessary to learn for the preparation of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N4.

■ Kanji Test: There are four kinds of tests.

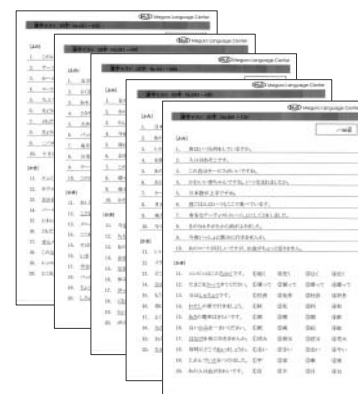

10 Kanji Test × 12 sheets



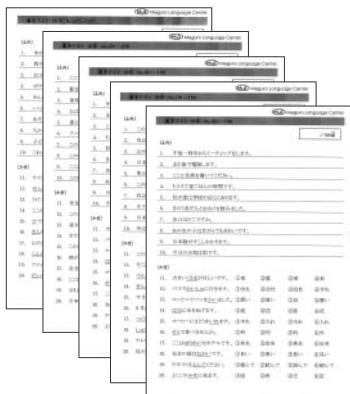
